Career Notes

Named to the 2005, 2006 and 2007 Southeastern Conference Winter Academic Honor Roll ... earned 2004 SEC Freshman Academic Honor Roll recognition ... 72 of her 77 made shots during her career were 3-pointers ... ranked 12th all-time for career 3-pointers (72) ... eighth-highest career 3-point percentage (32.1%, 72-224) at UF ... four double-figure scoring games.

Senior Year (2006-07)

Team co-captain ... starting guard in all 31 games ... recognized as the team's 'Unsung Hero' during the season-ending banquet ... earned SEC Academic Honor Roll status ... one of four Gators who played in every game ... UF's fifth-leading scorer among active players at season's end ... 41 of her 45 field goals were 3-pointers ... shot 31.3 percent (41-131) from the 3-point line ... collected a career-high five rebounds in the SEC Tournament first round game vs. Mississippi State (March 1) ... scored her 100th point of the season in the Jan. 28 game against Georgia, impressive considering that she had a career total of 100 points during her first three years combined ... scored a season-high 14 points against IUPUI (Nov. 21) ... played every minute of a game for the first time in her career, on the court for all 40 against Arkansas (Jan. 21) ... three double-figure scoring games.

Junior Year (2005-06)

Played in 28 games, scoring in 13 ... her 35.3 three-point field goal percentage

(24-68) ranked No. 8 in a season by a Gator ... 24 of her 25 field goals were three-pointers and only six attempts came from within the arc ... her lone trey against New Mexico (March 18) in the NCAA first round was her 100th career point ... netted a career-high 15 points on 5-of-7 three-point shooting against No. 19 Vanderbilt (Jan. 22), helping UF rally from a halftime deficit and post the upset win ... canned back-to-back treys midway through the second half against Alabama (Jan. 5) to cap UF's comeback and give the Gators the lead for good ... during UF's 11-game winning streak, shot 44.7 percent (17-of-38) from the three-point arc ... her 3-pointer with 9:03 remaining against UT-Arlington gave UF a 45-43 lead and the Gators never trailed again ... named to the SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll.

Sophomore Year (2004-05)

Suffered a season-ending injury to her left knee during the team's shoot-around prior to the January 9 game against Auburn, tearing the anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) and partially tearing the medial col-

lateral ligament and the medial meniscus ... underwent successful surgery on her knee February 7 ... named to the SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll ... appeared in 13 of 14 games prior to the injury ... came off the bench and drew a crucial charge at Arkansas (January 6) late in the second half when the Razorbacks were attempting a comeback ... contributed career-highs of four points and three rebounds against UCF (November 30).

Freshman Year (2003-04)

Played in a total of 10 games - two in SEC match-ups - totaling 39 minutes of action

... scored in three games, hitting one 3-pointer in each ... overall was 3-for-10 from the field and 3-for-9 from three-point range ... her SEC debut came versus Kentucky (Feb. 8), when she scored three points on 1-of-2 shooting (both 3-point attempts), with one assist and one rebound in five minutes ... scored first collegiate points on December 19 against Bethune-Cookman, finishing 1-of-2 from behind the arc with one assist and one rebound in nine minutes ... named to the SEC Freshman Academic Honor Roll.

Career Notes

Named to the 2005, 2006 and 2007 Southeastern Conference Winter Academic Honor Roll ... earned 2004 SEC Freshman Academic Honor Roll recognition ... recognized as a 2007 Honorable Mention Arthur Ashe Sports Scholar ... missed the 2005-06 season after undergoing microfracture surgery on her left knee, Oct. 5, 2005.

Senior Year (2006-07)

Team co-captain ... earned SEC Academic Honor Roll status and recognized as an Honorable Mention Arthur Ashe Sports Scholar ... one of four Gators who played in every game, earning 13 starts ... in the regular-season finale she made the most of her 'Senior Day' start, scoring 12 points and five rebounds while playing a career-long 38 minutes in the upset over Kentucky ... UF's fourth-leading scorer ... averaged 9.7 points with 5.0 rebounds in her final three collegiate games ... canned 24-of-26 from the free throw line, connecting on her last 13 free throws to end the year ... played the best basketball of her career over the final few games, when during a three-game stretch in February, averaged a team-best 16.3 points along with 6.7 rebounds, while shooting 8-of-17 (47.1%) from the 3-point arc and was 7-of-7 from the free throw line during those three games ... exploded for a career-high 23 points and eight rebounds at Kentucky (Feb. 4), hitting 20 points during UF's second-half

rally, which included a 4-of-6 effort from the 3-point arc - her first treys since her freshman year - and followed that with 13 points at LSU (Feb. 8) ... posted the first double-double of her career with 13 points and 11 rebounds against Mississippi State (Feb. 11) ... scored a then season-high 10 points in the season-opener against North Florida (Nov. 10) ... collected a then-career-high eight rebounds at Xavier (Nov. 12) ... scored in 10 of the first 11 games ... six double-figure scoring games ... one double-figure rebounding game ... one double-double.

Junior Year (2005-06)

Did not play in any games ... suited up for every game after the January 26 contest at Arkansas ... had microfracture surgery on her left knee on Oct. 5, 2005 ... named to the 2006 SEC Academic Honor Roll.

Sophomore Year (2004-05)

Appeared in all 29 games ... scored in 18 games, including each of the first five and six of the last eight ... named to the 2005 SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll

... scored a career-high 11 points against USF (March 17) in the season finale, hitting 5-of-5 from the floor and 1-of-2 free throws ... huge game off the bench in the win at Kentucky (Feb. 10), scoring seven points on 3-of-3 shooting, while dishing one assist and collecting one steal ... recorded the first double-figure scoring game of her career with 10 points while tying a career-high of four rebounds in the win against Akron (Nov. 27), playing a career-long 19 minutes ... had more offensive rebounds (26) than defensive boards (15) ... two double-figure scoring games.

Freshman Year (2003-04)

Played in 10 games, totaling 46 minutes of action ... scored a season-high nine points with four rebounds while playing a season-long 16 minutes against Bethune-Cookman (Dec. 19) ... saw her first collegiate action against LaSalle (Nov. 23) and scored her first collegiate basket in the win ... named to the 2004 SEC Freshman Academic Honor Roll.
