## **FACILITY:**

- Track: 200m polyurethane track; 6-42” lanes on oval, 82’ radius makes the track one of the fastest in the U.S.; 9-42” lanes on the straight
- Field Events: The long jump, triple jump and pole vault runways are a mondo board surface.
- Maximum length of spikes: ¼”

## **CONDUCT OF MEET:**

- 55m and 55m Hurdles: Trials and finals will be conducted. Top 9 times will advance to the final.
- 200m and 400m: We will use lanes – 3-4-5-6. With the preferred lanes being 5&6
- All other running events will be seeded and conducted as finals, in sections against time if more than one section required.
- In the long jump, triple jump, shot put and weight all participants will be allowed 3 trials with the top 9 marks advancing to the finals.

## **RULES/ELIGIBILITY:**

- Events will be conducted under NCAA rules. All athletes representing intercollegiate programs must be eligible according to respective NCAA rules.

## **ENTRY INFORMATION:**

- 1) \$15.00 per athlete entered (max \$200 per team/\$400 both). ). Entry fees must be paid at packet pick-up. Make checks payable to “**University Athletic Association**”
